

Professional and Business Services Employment Compared to Series Peak Red areas indicate recessions








Trade and Transportation up 0.3%

Trade, Transportation, and Utilities Employment Compared to Series Peak Red areas indicate recessions








Financial Activities down 2.6%


- Employment: up 11,589

Unemployment for individuals who are not job losers or who have been unemployed for 14 weeks or less








Most people unemployed under 10 weeks

Median and Mean number of weeks unemployed








Nonparticipants - Discouraged

Twelve Month Average through 2023 Q1 unemployed and Discouraged Workers





Twelve Month Average through 2023 Q1 Unemployed and Marginally Attached Workers






Unemployment by Education

Unemployment Rate - Bachelor's Degree and Higher, 25 Yrs. & Over


